# How to Complete an MPS School Request

- **Gather Information and** learn about placement options for Pre-K through grade 12:
  - Visit [ExploreMPS.org](https://www.mpls.k12.mn.us/explore), attend school tours.
  - Reach out to the Enrollment Team with questions: 612.668.1840 or [sps.department@mpls.k12.mn.us](mailto:sps.department@mpls.k12.mn.us)
- **Request up to three schools.**
  - If your first choice is your community school, you do not need to add any other schools.
  - If you are requesting one magnet and your community school, you do not need to add a third choice.
  - If you are requesting two magnets, we recommend that you list your community school as your third choice
- **Submit your request on or before Feb 7, 2023** Requests received by the due date can be included in the 2023-2024 school request lottery and assure you a placement notification update during the first week of March 2023.
- High Five students attending their community school will be automatically enrolled in Kindergarten at that school. Others wishing to request Kindergarten must submit a request. High Five students at will also be automatically enrolled in kindergarten at that school.
- Proof of address will be required for students who are new to MPS, have a new address, or are requesting an oversubscribed school.
- Please refer to the chart below to determine if you qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- You have the best chance of receiving your top school or program by requesting before the due date of February 7, 2023

## High Five Information

High Five is a preschool program for children who turn four on or by September 1 and who will start kindergarten the following fall. High Five primarily offers half-day enrollment, with limited full-day seats available. For more information, visit <http://ece.mpls.k12.mn.us>.

High Five students must meet the following **eligibility requirements** to be eligible for consideration:

- Students must be at least four years old on or by September 1.
- Students must complete a preschool screening prior to the first day of school. Call 612.668.3715 to make an appointment.
- Priority placement will be given to students who qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- Priority placement will be given to Minneapolis residents.

## Sliding Fee Scale for High Five

- The sliding fee scale establishes a recommended payment for service based on family income and family size.
- No child will be excluded because of their family's inability to pay.
- The fee for High Five is waived for children who qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program).
- Families who do not qualify for Educational Benefits (the free/reduced-price lunch program) will be charged based on a sliding-fee scale.
